SUMMARY OF REQUEST (GENERAL DESCRIPTION, FINANCING, OTHER OPERATIONAL IMPACT, POSSIBLE ALTERNATIVES) Community Mental Health Services requests approval to establish positions and transfer vacant CMH positions to the CMH Court Collaboratives program to establish an intensive in-home program. The program will serve children and adolescents involved with the delinquency, abuse/neglect, and mental health systems. It will be staffed through new partnerships between CMH, Family Court (FC), Department of Human Services (DHS) and the Intermediate School District (ISD). Juveniles entering the justice system will be assessed by Family Court for mental health disorders that, if not treated, place the youth at risk for residential placement. Muskegon County's small service array for these individuals frequently leads to expensive out of County and out of State residentialplacements. Some of the								
current residential placements are youth who have committed simple misdemeanor violations and who left the community because there were no suitable in County services available to meet their needs. The residential placements can be very costly to the child care fund and are not very effective in changing behavior that occurs while the child is in the community. The new service will provide consistent and long term family and community oriented services to prevent out of home placementand, for those who must be placed for a time, provide a safe and effective program for their return.								
CMH has funding available for these positions within the current budget. A grant for evaluation of the outcomes of the service is expected. Long term funding will be based on results shown in the evaluation in terms of reductions in use of out of county residential services and individual and family growth arising from the services.								
Cost of the new positions is \$45,200 for FY 2011 and \$163,012 for FY 2012. County match required is \$1,276 for FY 2011 and \$4,600 for FY 2012.

SUMMARY OF REQUEST (GENERAL DESCRIPTION, FINANCING, OTHER OPERATIONAL IMPACT, POSSIBLE ALTERNATIVES)								
Congress provided an additional \$1 billion in funding for the Neighborhood Stabilization Program through the Dodd-Frank Act. Funds were allocated to states and units of local government based on funding formulas established by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). Muskegon County was awarded \$1,071,000 through this allocation. A public hearing must be held to allow citizen comments on the Request for the Release of Funds from HUD and the Finding of No Significant Environmental Impact. We are requesting that the public hearing be held on July 26, 2011. No work may proceed on the rehabilitation of the houses until the public hearing has been held following the completion of the environmental review of the eight properties that will be rehabilitated.
