SUMMARY OF REQUEST (GENERAL DESCRIPTION, FINANCING, OTHER OPERATIONAL IMPACT, POSSIBLE ALTERNATIVES)								
Authorization is requested for Community Mental Health Services of Muskegon County (CMH) to amend the contracts with <b>Amanda Family, Inc.</b> (Amanda AFC) <b>and Fa-Ho-Lo Family, Inc.</b> (Wolf Lake AFC), (6266 Lazy Oak Trail, Muskegon, MI 49442) to increase the per diem paid for each home to cover the purchase of a new 15- passenger lift van for the Wolf Lake home, and the purchase of a mini-van to be shared between the two homes. The corporations are requesting the per diem paid for the Wolf Lake home be increased by \$5.68 to \$176.61 (3.3% increase), and the per diem paid for the Amanda home be increased by \$0.93 to \$209.20 (.4% increase).								
The Wolf Lake home will return the van they currently lease from CMH, and both the Wolf Lake and Amanda homes will no longer need to borrow vans from CMH to transport residents to activities and appointments. Due to the number of mobility impaired residents in these two homes, Amanda and Wolf Lake have been frequent users of borrowed CMH vehicles to transport their residents. At this point, Amanda Family, Inc. will continue to lease their CMH van, so there will be three vans available for both homes.

Authorization is requested for Community Mental Health Services of Muskegon County (CMH) to amend the contract with <b>Insight Telepsychiatry</b> , <b>LLC</b> (2559 Lawrence Highway, Charlotte, MI 48813) for the provision of Telepsychiatry Services from an average of eight (8) hours per week to forty (40) hours per week per each adult and child psychiatrist, effective March 1, 2013, at a cost of \$195.00 per hour for child/adolescent services and \$175.00 per hour for adult services.								
CMH has been utilizing locum tenens psychiatrists since June 2012 through our affiliation agreement with Ottawa CMH, for which we have paid the hourly rate of \$185.00 and daily rate of \$30.00, as well as the doctors' housing and transportation costs. The current locum tenens child psychiatrist will be providing services through telepsychiatry from mid-December 2012 to April, 2013, so CMH will save on the transportation and housing costs. CMH is having continual issues with the high costs of locum tenens physicians and would like to have the option of contracting for telepsychiatry physicians until such time as we are able to secure full time permanent psychiatrists.

Authorization is requested for Community Mental Health (CMH) to reclassify a current Administrative Analyst position #X04005 (NX 00220), to an Accountant I position (NX 00130), effective April 15, 2015. The total decreased cost for this change would be (\$8,497). The total cost decrease to the County General Fund would be (\$681).							
We no longer need this supervisory position; however, there is a real need for a higher level non-supervisory position within the Finance Division of CMH. This position will assist the two Mental Health Claims Supervisors, and the Mental Health Chief Financial Officer to perform higher level accounting functions. This need comes about due to a significant increase in the workload of these three staff. Some of these items are as follows: Formation of Regional Entity, Autism Benefit, SED Waiver Program, DHS Incentive Program, general increase in the youth population and outpatient services, new software requirements at the County level, P-card processing, and increased data submitting requirements to the Department of Community Health.
