**CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Snider at 3:44 p.m.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

**ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION**

CPS12/04 – 18 It was moved by Engle, supported by Plummer, to approve the purchase of the in-car camera system for the Sheriff's fleet including the add-on 4RE switch for a total cost of \$167,684.00. Motion Carried.

CPS12/04 – 19 It was moved by Plummer, supported by Engle, to approve the addition of a seventh Season Marine Officer position and to fill this position immediately. Motion Carried.

CPS12/04 - 20      It was moved by Engle, supported by Plummer, to authorize staff to apply for funds from the Homeland Security Department under the Port Security Grant Program (CFDA 97.056) in the amount of \$305,000 with a 25% County match of \$101,667.  
Motion Carried.

CPS12/04 – 21      It was moved by Engle, supported by Plummer, to accept the equipment funding from the Office of Highway Safety Planning in the amount of \$27,000, amend the grant Agreement and adjust the County budget accordingly.  
Motion Carried.
