MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Hughes at 4:00 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

It was moved by Mahoney, supported by Sabo, to approve the minutes of the January 9, 2014, meeting as written. Motion carried.

PRESENTATION

Commissioner Hughes introduced Tom VanBruggen, GIS Administrator, and asked that he share information regarding fire hydrant inventory.

Mr. Tom VanBruggen informed those present that Muskegon County GIS, Muskegon County Public Works, Muskegon Area Storm Water Committee, City of Norton Shores and Muskegon Township Public Works are all working together to develop a web based interactive mapping application for Muskegon County fire hydrant viewing. It was noted that this information is found to be very helpful by the local fire chiefs and public works officials.

Mr. VanBruggen noted there are currently 14 different mapping applications and currently four free applications for viewing which include: property information, Land Bank properties, voting locations and business park information.

The Commissioners thanked Mr. VanBruggen for this information.

- CPS14/02 – 04 It was moved by Sabo, supported by Wilkins, to authorize the reclassification of one (1) Departmental Clerk to one (1) Child Support Specialist. Motion carried.
- CPS14/02 – 05 It was moved by Nash, supported by Sabo, to approve acceptance of the FY2014 Strategic Traffic Enforcement Grant in the amount of \$48,000.00 and to amend the County budget accordingly. Motion carried.
- CPS14/02 – 06 It was moved by Nash, supported by Mahoney, to authorize the Sheriff's Office to seek competitive bids for the purchase of four (4) used vehicles, the trade-in of eight (8) current Sheriff fleet vehicles and to lease one (1) new Chevy Pursuit Tahoe for the K-9 unit, one (1) Ford Police SUV (partial replacement cost through HR following US-31 accident), three (3) Ford Police SUV's and two (2) Ford Transit Connect vehicles for Animal Control, all vehicles are to be equipped with necessary equipment. Motion carried.
- CPS14/02 – 07 It was moved by Sabo, supported by Mahoney, to authorize moving two (2) currently unfunded Sheriff Deputy – Hourly positions (S05046 & S05050) to funded status and allow the Sheriff to fill these positions effective February 13, 2014. Motion carried.
