Roger Nye, a member of the Occupy Muskegon movement, addressed the Board concerning the needs of senior citizens for transportation.

Joshua EldenBrady addressed the Board concerning jail project concerns. He indicated that out of 10 requirements for public defenders the County does not meet any of them and that while there may need to be a new facility, there are other issues to be considered. Mr. Brady shared that the problems of the jail need to be addressed, not just a new facility which will house more inmates.
