

GENEALOGY

Searching of Death and Marriage records will be handled one of the following ways:

Any person wishing to view Death or Marriage indexes or records in the Muskegon County Clerk's Office may do so during our regular business hours. No reproduction equipment, coats, scarves, mittens or other outerwear are allowed when doing research. All research must be done in pencil, and all researchers must sign in and may be asked to provide ID. The person doing research is limited to one hour to review the information if there is another person waiting. No young children please.

Alternatively, individuals may leave the information to be researched with the County Clerk's Staff to give to the Genealogy Society to research for a fee. Records transcribed by hand will be \$6.00 for each record plus \$15 per hour processing time, with copies being mailed to the requester upon completion. Payment is to be made at the time of the request.

Genealogists are only available on Wednesday afternoon from 1:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m. to assist in your research efforts.

Certified copies of records are available at any time for \$15.00 for the first copy and \$5.00 for each additional copy of the same record.

*Birth records for genealogy are only available when the birth occurred more than 100 years ago and can only be obtained by an heir, with proof of death.
