The Muskegon County Water Resources Commissioner will meet on the above date, time and location to receive construction bids for the Peterson Road Drain. Bids will then be opened and publicly announced.

The Peterson Road Drain project will be let in one (1) section as follows, each section having the length, average depth and width as set forth:

Work generally described as: Construction of 1,265 lineal feet of 12-inch storm sewer, 546 lineal feet of 18-inch storm sewer, 584 lineal feet of 18-inch culvert, and 2,490 lineal feet of 24-inch storm sewer with associated appurtenances including 28 drainage structures, 52 end sections, and 3,507 lineal feet of open drain cleanout; and also including HMA, concrete, and gravel roadway and driveway restoration, and lawn restoration.

This Notice of Letting, the plans, specifications and bid proposal shall be considered a part of the Contract. The Contract will be let in accordance with the Contract Documents now on file at the Muskegon County Water Resources Commissioner's Office, 141 E. Apple Avenue, Muskegon, MI 49441 and Eng., Inc. office at 16930 Robbins Road, Suite 105, Grand Haven, MI 49417 and available to interested parties.
