



### MUSKEGON COUNTY, MICHIGAN BALLOT PROPOSALS AUGUST 6, 2019 PRIMARY ELECTION OFFICIAL

#### MUSKEGON COUNTY

#### **Veterans Millage Renewal**

Shall the millage approved by Muskegon County voters in 1994 and renewed in 1998 and 2008 for the purpose of providing funds to equip, operate, maintain and defray debt service and provide support and assistance to Veterans through a County Department of Veterans Affairs be renewed and continued (and the limitation continue to be maintained) by an amount not to exceed 1/13<sup>th</sup> mill (\$0.077 per \$1,000) on taxable value on all property in the County of Muskegon, for an additional period of ten (10) years, being 2019 through 2028, inclusive, resulting in an annual estimated revenue of \$330,534 for 2019?

#### **CITY OF NORTH MUSKEGON**

### **Bond Proposal**

Shall the City of North Muskegon, Muskegon County, Michigan, borrow the principal sum of not to exceed One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds payable over a period not to exceed eleven (11) years from date of issuance, to provide funds to be used by the City for the purpose of paying the cost of acquiring and constructing park improvements for the benefit of the City and its residents, including constructing and reconstructing structures, courts and playfields, acquiring equipment, and improving and developing sites? The estimated millage to be levied in 2020 is 1.1313 mills (\$1.1313 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and the estimated simple average annual millage rate required to retire the bonds is 1.1357 mills (\$1.1357 per \$1,000 of taxable value).

# Fire Department Millage Renewal

This millage is a renewal of the previously authorized millage. Shall the total tax rate limitation of \$15.00
per \$1,000.00 of state taxable value for Egelston Township continue to be increased by two mills (\$2.00
per \$1,000.00 of the taxable value) of which 1.9920 mill is a renewal and 0.0080 mill is Headlee
reduction restoration, by the renewal of the levy of said amount on all property in Egelston Township for
ten years beginning in the year 2019, to fund the continuation of operation of the Egelston Township
Fire Department? (If approved it is estimated that this levy will generate \$379,414.08 in revenue in the
first calendar year.)
